BAC – 2 Nursing and Instructional Building – Exterior Design

Background Information

The scope of this project will include the demolition of the existing McIver Building and the construction of a new building consisting of laboratory and support space, academic teaching facilities and offices. The project also includes construction of a stand-alone chiller plant.

TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET: \$105,000,000

This Board, at its July 14, 2016 meeting, selected the firm of LS3P Associates Ltd., Raleigh, NC, as the designer for the Nursing and Instructional Building project. The site for the Nursing and Instructional Building is indicated on the Campus Master Plan update approved by the Board of Trustees in February 2014, and the design has progressed to the point that it is complete enough to seek approval.

Recommendation

That the Board of Trustees of The University of North Carolina at Greensboro approve the exterior design for the Nursing and Instructional Building and authorize administration to proceed with completing the design and construction of this building.

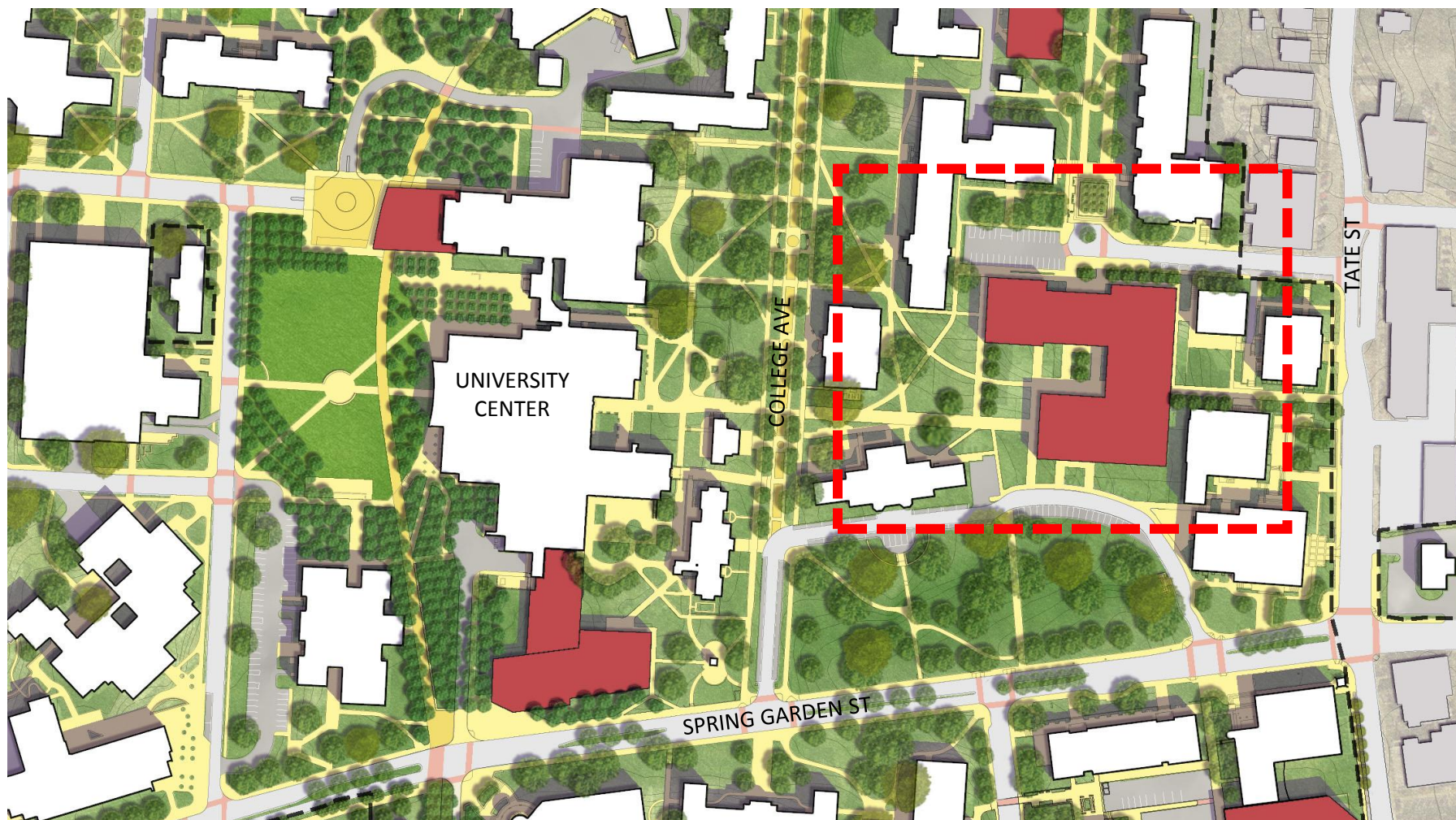

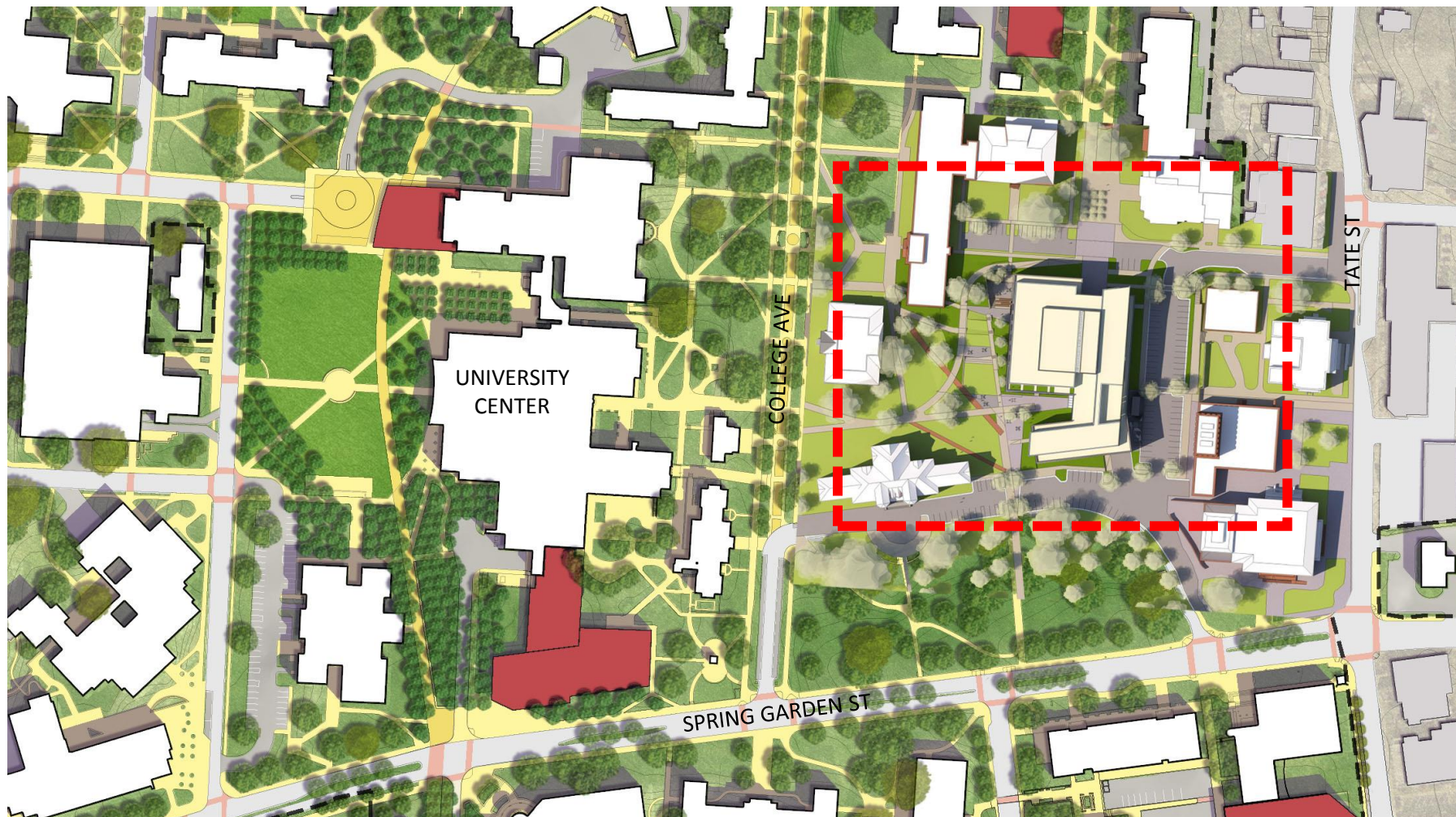
