BAC-8 Report on Architects and Engineers Appointed by Chancellor (Weil Winfield Residence Hall Fire Alarm System Replacement)

## **Background Information**

At the December 6, 2013 meeting of the UNCG Board of Trustees, the Board authorized the Chancellor, ex-officio, to appoint architects and engineers for projects with authorized funding of \$2,000,000 or less, and authorized the Chancellor to report all such appointments to the Board at its next meeting.

The scope of this project is design studies for Weil Winfield Fire Alarm Replacement.

TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET: \$903,000

The firm of Sigma Engineered Solutions, PC, Morrisville, NC, was recommended to the Chancellor for this appointment because of the following reasons:
