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What is Spartan StartUp?

Five-week, rigorous academic experience which provides a “head start” for first-year students and supports them through the transition to college.



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Spartan StartUp Provides

- Exposure to the academic environment with the opportunity to earn 7 credit hours
- Exposure to targeted academic support services
- Exposure to hybrid courses
- Exposure to many of UNCG's campus resources
- Exposure to co-curricular and extra-curricular activities
- All costs covered by Pell Grant and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation

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Student Feedback

- Students said they felt more prepared for online courses after participating in Start-Up
- Students felt the 5-week time frame and 7 credits was challenging but manageable
- Students enjoyed the opportunity to learn and utilize campus resources
- Students felt faculty were engaging and supportive
- Students noted they struggled with time management and requested more time to complete assignments



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Spartan StartUp Students

- Total Number of Enrolled Students: 42
- 83% had a GPA of 2.0 or better
- 50% had a GPA of 3.0 or better
- 40 students enrolled for Fall 2018



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2019-2020 Spartan StartUp Selection Criteria

- Total Number of Enrolled Students: 40
- Cost Associated with Participation
- Targeting students by GPA/Standardized Test Score Ranges
- Focusing on Exploratory Majors
- Candidates must satisfy two of the following
 - Low-income
 - Underrepresented
 - First-Generation
