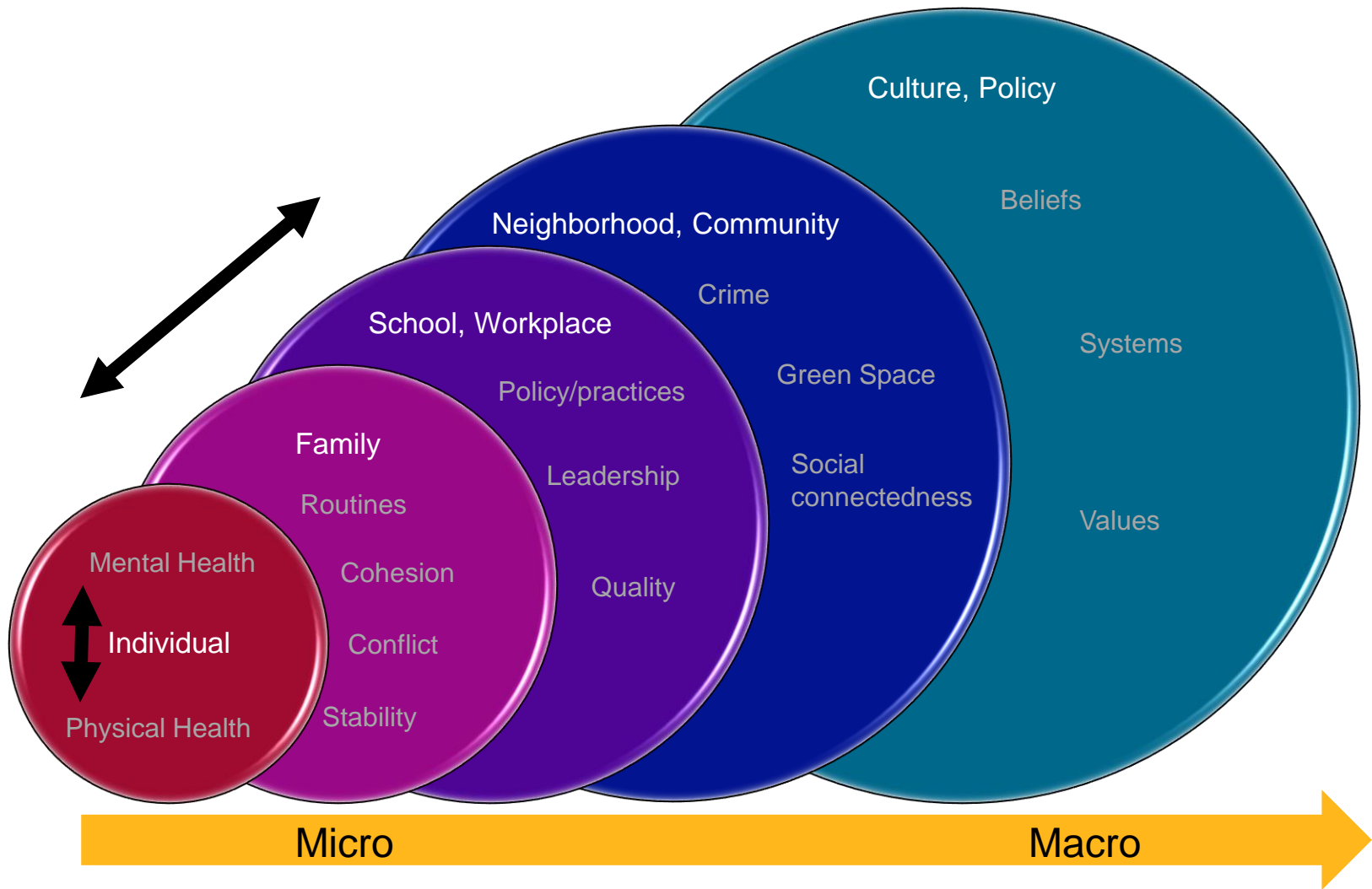

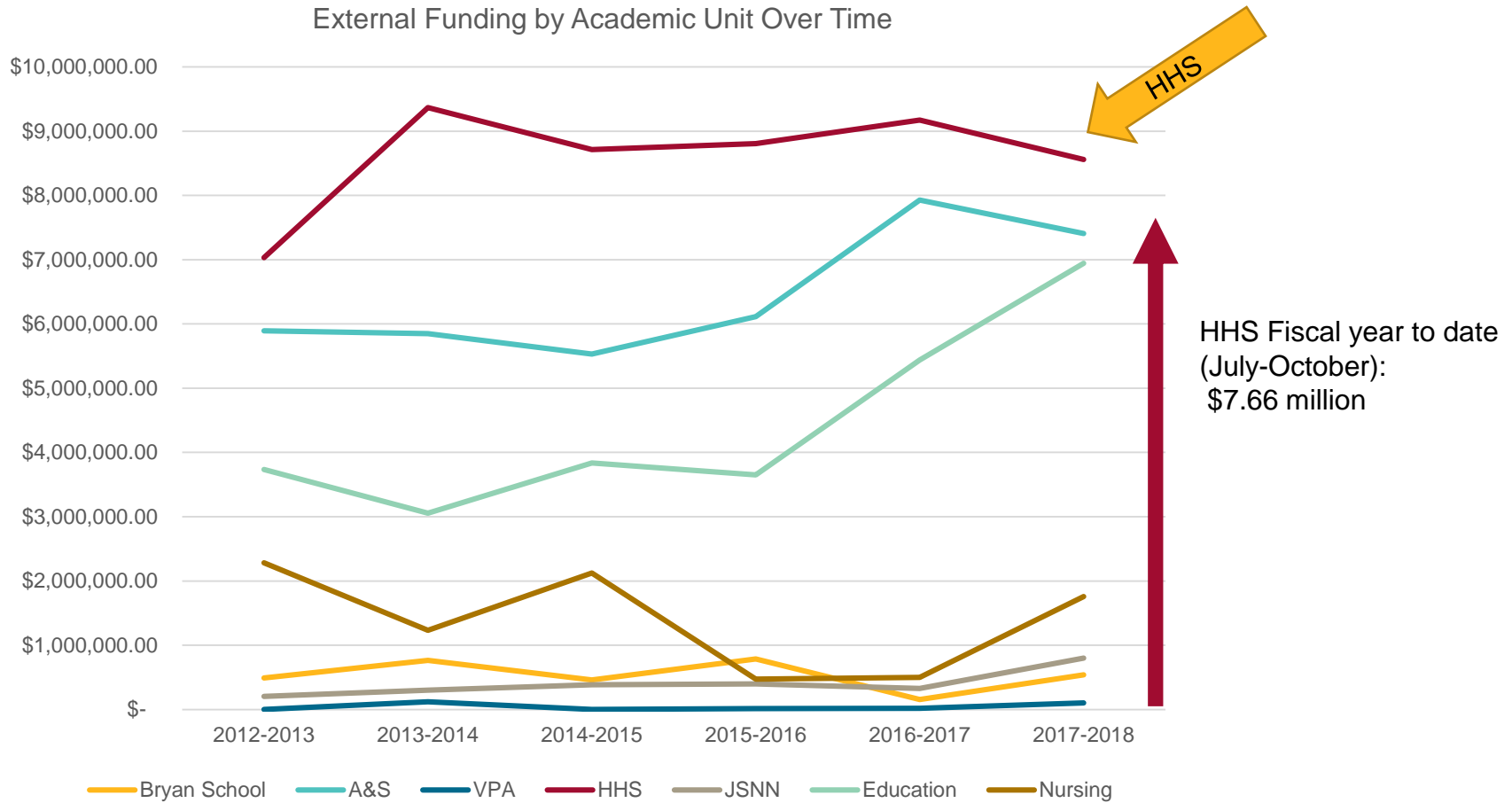

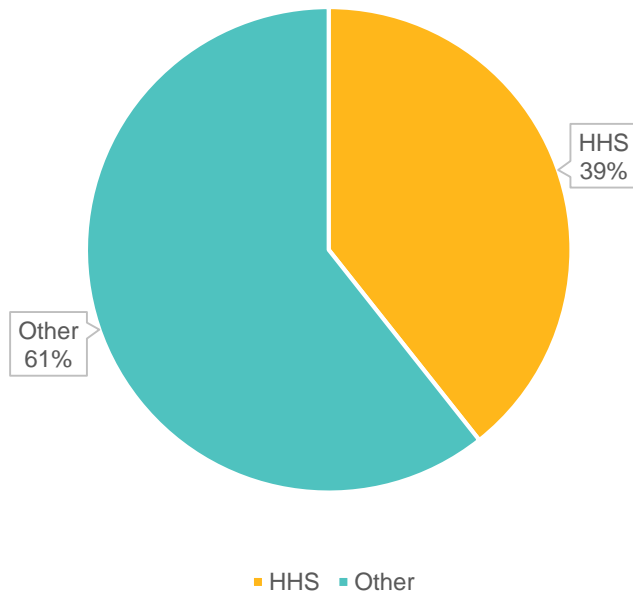
HHS Research Facts

External Funding Over Time

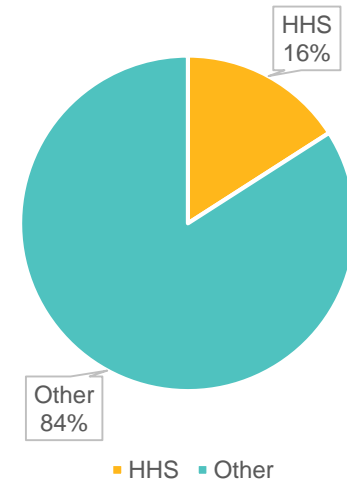


Since 2012, UNC Greensboro has generated \$189 million in external funding. Of that, \$131 million was generated by the **7 academic units**. Of that \$131 million:

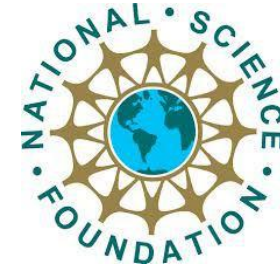
