The Three-minute Thesis (3MT) competition is an event that challenges master's and doctoral students to explain their research to a general audience in only three minutes with the use of a single static PowerPoint slide. The original competition was held at the University of Queensland in Australia in 2008; today there are hundreds of 3MT events each year around the globe. UNCG hosts its 3MT in November, with our winner advancing to the regional competition each February.
