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ABSTINENCE HOSTILE ENVIRONMENT

- College campuses have often been referred to as "abstinence hostile environments"
- Students in recovery face the same challenges as other students:
 - Academics, finances, work etc., and
 - difficulty being admitted due to the consequences of their previous substance use, potential challenges obtaining tuition assistance, and maintaining their recovery etc.



ADDICTION IS ABOUT PEOPLE


- 1.7 million full-time college students (18–22) reported current use of an illicit substance
 - 6.1% met the criteria for an alcohol use disorder
 - •1,220 UNC Greensboro students
 - 11.2% met the criteria for an illicit substance use disorder
 - •2,240 UNC Greensboro students
 - Estimated 4% of students on campus are in recovery
 - 800 UNC Greensboro students
