  - Bottom line we will received \$104M if GA approves UNCSO budget. UNCG slated for 10.48% of planned total distribution
  - Our overall deferred maintenance burden is >\$500M. \$30M alone for roof repair/replacement. So \$104M is a good news/bad news story





- Current Budget Year, FY 20-21
  - State Funds are stable and budget to actual is on target
  - NC Budget is in a surplus position
  - Without stimulus, our financial picture would be not as positive

#### • FY21-22

- \$3.2M state appropriations cut tied to enrollment decline
- Impact of fall enrollment, housing, dining, parking, etc. TBD



## Tuition and Fees/Good News

#### Tuition and Fees

- Flat, based on the mix between Regular Term, resident and nonresident which is down and distance which is up for both resident and nonresident
- No further cuts required this budget year unless the state surprises us with a management flex cut


