FAC-1 New Capital Project – Weatherspoon Art Museum Center for Art and **Human Understanding** 

## **Background Information**

On May 22, 2019, the Board of Governors delegated authorization of capital improvement projects designed, constructed, and operated by non-general fund money, with a total project cost of \$750,000 to \$4,000,000, to the Board of Trustees. The cost of the Weatherspoon Art Museum Center for Art and Human Understanding project is within this threshold.

The project will renovate roughly 3,200 square feet of first-floor galleries, storage, and transition spaces to create the Center. The program consists of a new reception area, collections storage, and a flexible object-study gallery to advance the work of Weatherspoon curators, faculty, students, and museum interns. The Center will provide ready access to the museum's internationally renowned collection of 6,500 works of art through a purpose-designed space for teaching, learning, and research. The Center will dramatically increase the collection's usefulness for academic & community engagement and student wellness. The Center aims to transform teaching with art, making the museum a greater asset for student success. It will serve as a national model for its innovative programs and engagement with the greater community.
