Background Information

Interim Dean Bhadury will be accompanied by Spartan CyberGuardian Academy principal investigator, Dr. Moez Farokhnia and co-principal investigator, Dr. Lakshmi Iyer. They will present on the \$1 million in grant funding and wraparound support from Google's Cybersecurity Clinics Fund. The grant will establish the Spartan CyberGuardian Academy (SCGA), a cybersecurity clinic at UNCG, which will train 870 students to assist 174 organizations over the next six years.



- 3 types of Students:
 - 1. Graduate Students → Trained in the ISSCM Program → Network+, Security+
 - 2. Undergraduate Students \rightarrow Trained in the ISSCM Program \rightarrow Network+, A+
 - 3. General Audience \rightarrow other departments, high schools, Community Colleges
- Admission to the clinic:
 - 1. Acceptable performance in the prerequisite courses
 - 2. Completion of MIT Online training
 - 3. Complete application
- Semester Long training (Google Cybersecurity Certification, CompTIA special trainings)
